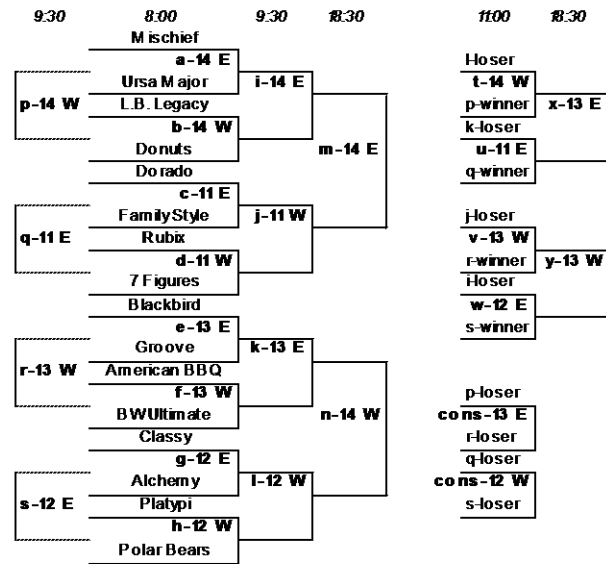
What **CANNOT** go in the bins:
