
WELCOME

Welcome to Tempe! This year's New Year Fest, our 21st, is a tribute to Russ "Big Kahuna" Symmes. Most players here at New Year Fest may never have had the opportunity to meet, or especially pal around with, Russ, but it isn't an exaggeration to say that Russ was one of those rare people that always made everyone around him feel important and happy.

Russ transitioned from being a huge offensive lineman for the ASU Sun Devils in the late 70s to being a huge (and svelte) long on the Plastic Surgeons, and other 80's Phoenix teams. By the late 80's, Russ was floating a good portion of the shoestring operation that was the New Year Fest out of his own pocket. Thanks to his efforts and others in those early years, the tournament you're playing in this weekend continued to grow to the size and stature it is today.

In about 1991 Russ was diagnosed with brain cancer. His original prognosis was not hopeful. Doctors estimated he had 6 months. Russ battled through 3 brain surgeries, numerous seizures, and lots of therapy, always maintaining his characteristic sunny attitude. Returning to the fields whenever he could, Russ credited ultimate with helping him stave off what eventually became inevitable. Russ passed away this past December. We will be having a tribute at Frisbee Central between the first two rounds at Frisbee Central Saturday morning from 11:30 to 11:45.




PLAYER INFORMATION

NYF 2003 RULES

last updated 1/31/03

Except where otherwise stated, NYF will run under the UPA's 10th Edition rules. Copies will be distributed at the Captains' Meeting.

* Open

- Pool games on Saturday are to 13, win by two, point cap at 15.
- Quarters are to 15, win by two, point cap at 17.
- Semis are to 15, win by two, point cap at 17.
- Finals to 17, win by two, point cap at 19.
- * Women
- Pool games on Saturday are to 13, win by two, point cap at 15.
- Quarters are to 15, win by two, point cap at 17
- Semis are to 15, win by two, point cap at 17
- Finals to be determined by captains.
- 15-yard brick on out-of-bounds pulls.
- * Mirror image, no half. Finals will have a mirror halftime
- * Three timeouts per team, per game. No more than two timeouts per half.
- * Once a game reaches overtime (i.e., 12-12 in pool play) each team is entitled to exactly one timeout, provided they have one available.
- * Up to two substitutions per team, per timeout.
- * Games will be soft-capped 30 minutes prior to the start of the next round. At the sound of the soft cap horn, a team that has timeouts still available is permitted to use no more than one. (If a soft-capped game subsequently reaches overtime, a team that has already called a timeout during soft cap does not receive an additional timeout.) At the completion of the point in progress when the soft cap horn sounds, add two points to the highest current score, and that is the new point cap for the game. (For capping purposes, a point is considered to be in progress as soon as the preceding point has ended.) **Note that win-by-two is no longer required**, but any team that reaches 13 or more by a margin of two or more will be the winner of the game.
- * Games will be hard-capped 10 minutes before the start of the next round. At the completion of the point in progress when the hard-cap horn sounds, the team in the lead is the winner. If the game is tied after the completion of that point, one more point is played to determine the winner. No timeouts (except injury timeouts) may be called once the hard-cap horn has sounded.
- * Seeding for playoffs will be based on won/lost record during pool play. Tiebreakers will be applied in the following order: head-to-head record; point differential in games between tied teams; point differential against all common opponents; total point differential; disc flip.


